

**The scoring principles of the National Higher Education Scholarship  
in the Faculty of Health Sciences and Social Studies, University of Szeged**

**For a scholarship application maximum 100 points can be given.** The grade point average is calculated according to the academic average, based on at least 90% of 100% academic performance at the Faculty, 4.50

<b>I. Academic result</b> (ten times the average of the corrected credit indexes of the 2 semesters of the current academic year – rounded to an integer)	<b>max. 60 points</b>
<b>II. Foreign language proficiency certificate, foreign language proficiency from languages different from the language of the training program (only accredited certificates can be considered) max.10 points</b>	
<i>Certificate of basic level language examination, type “C” (oral and written)</i>	<b>3 points</b>
<i>Certificate of basic level language examination, type “A” (oral) or “B” (written)</i>	<b>2 points</b>
<i>Certificates of intermediate or advanced level language examinations, type “A” (oral) or “B” (written)</i>	<b>5 points</b>
<i>Certificate of intermediate level language examination, type “C” (oral and written)</i>	<b>8 points</b>
<i>Certificate of advanced level language examination, type “C” (oral and written)</i>	<b>10 points</b>

<b>Professional recommendation (max. 2 points)</b>	
TDK supervisor's recommendation	<b>2 points</b>
<b>IV. Points for public, sport and other activities (max. 10 points)</b>	
Work in a professional self-help or civil or foundation organization, certified by a referee, for at least 40 hours at least half a year in 1 year before the scholarship application (min. 2 points, max. 10 points depending on the working period)	<b>max. 10 points</b>
Outstanding activity in HÖK (Faculty Students' Union), certified by a referee, for at least half a year in 1 year before the scholarship application	<b>4 points</b>
Outstanding activity in the dormitory, certified by a referee, for at least half a year in 1 year before the scholarship application	<b>4 points</b>
Work in a non-professional self-help or civil or foundation organization, certified by a referee, for at least half a year in 1 year before the scholarship application	<b>4 points</b>
Completed student work in the own specialization, in health care or in social field - one year before the submission of the scholarship application, for at least half a year	<b>4 points</b>
Other voluntary work <b>one year before the submission of the scholarship application, at least in a half-year period</b> (certified by reference)	<b>4 points</b>
Ranked 1 <sup>st</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup> place in an international competition (during the training program)	<b>10 points</b>
Ranked national 1 <sup>st</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup> place in domestic sport competitions (during the training program)	<b>5 points</b>
International, outstanding sport achievement in the academic year of the submission of the scholarship application at least in a half-year period (certified by Association, Club)	<b>8 points</b>
Domestic, outstanding sport achievement in the academic year of the submission of the scholarship application at least in a half-year period (certified by Association, Club)	<b>6 points</b>
Regular and certified trainer or referee activity in the academic year of the submission of the scholarship application at least in a half-year period	<b>4 points</b>
<b>Artistic activity one year before the submission of the scholarship application, certified by reference</b>	<b>4 points</b>
