Essential information regarding the 1st semester of the academic year

2026/2027

Important dates:

- **Neptun regular course registration period:** 31.08.2026-20.09.2026
- **Neptun exam registration period:** 30.11. 2026 5 pm -24 hours before the start of the exam

Academic periods:

- **Education period:** 07.09.2026-12.12.2026
- **Examination period:** 14.12.2026-30.01.2027
- **Repeat examination period:** 01.02.2027-06.02.2027
- **Holidays:** 24.12.2026 - 04.01.2027

Deadlines:

- For the attention of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students: **tuition fee** has to be credited in 3 parts through Simple Pay system (online payment with bankcard) in Neptun. You have to pay through the Simple Pay System in Neptun, if you wish to be certain that your fees arrive in time. Right after your online payment in Neptun, the system changes the status of the tuition fee invoice from active to fulfilled.
- **Course registration** should be made from 31st August till 20th September.
- **“Only-exam” course registration** requests should be submitted till 20th September in MODULO.
- **Passive status requests:** till 20th September in MODULO.
- **Exceptional study schedule requests:** till 20th September in MODULO.
- **“Late” course registration and course dropping requests:** 21th September, 2026 – 09th October 2026 in MODULO.
- **Credit transfer requests:** for first year students: from 24th August – 6th September 2026
- **Credit transfer for the next semester for every student:** from 23th November – 6th December 2026



Neptun course registration: Please note that it is your right and obligation to sign up for every compulsory course before the course registration period closes (20th September).

Make sure you sign up for all your courses:

- lectures and practices / seminars
- physical education (2 semesters required during your studies) –
- optional courses (12 credits required during your studies)
- 2 criteria courses (AI in University Studies and IT Security at SZTE - completion with e-learning)

As per the current Academic and Examination Regulations of the University of Szeged, altering your course registration (adding or dropping courses) after the Neptun course registration period is only possible until 09th October, 2026 by submitting your request in Modulo.

Tuition fee:

If you are not able to pay through the Simple Pay system in Neptun, it can be made via wire transfer in the following way:

In the Remarks/Comments field please indicate the legal name and Neptun code of the student, the name of the program (Physiotherapist BSc or Nurse BSc) and your semester (first, second etc).

Please, make sure that the exact amount of the tuition fee is credited to the University's account.

Commission charges (if any) have to be paid by the applicant.

Please, also send the proof of payment to the International Office via e-mail with the subject: "Proof of payment of the tuition fee"

Please note that in case the payment is conducted by wire transfer it will take a few days for us to get the report from the Financial Dept (since it is not directly paid through the online application system).

Cash payment is not possible!

In case the students' academic progress does not follow the suggested study plan, tuition fee might be changed according to the "Regulations on the reduction of tuition fees":

Registration

You are required to register for the semester in order to have an active student status. The registration is conducted online: once you complete all the registration requirements and you have paid the tuition fee, your status will be activated in Neptun.

Registration requirements:

- **Tuition fee** (1st instalment) has to arrive to the University's bank account by 10th September, 2026. Please make sure that your fees are paid well in advance (in the case of wire transfer) so that they arrive by the deadline.

Valid health insurance: at the Students' Service Office you can sign the contract and can get the card. Your tuition fee includes the price of the insurance.

- You are required to settle all of your **fees** before the examination registration period, as uncompleted fees on Neptun might block your examination registration.

UNLESS YOU REGISTER PROPERLY BY THE DEADLINE, YOUR ACTIVE STUDENT STATUS AND COURSE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE SUSPENDED. Furthermore, you are not eligible to receive any certificate or transcript until your registration is complete.

Number of credits you have to earn is 240 during your whole studies out of which should be 12 elective credits.

Attendance of classes:

Please read the requirements of attendance thoroughly in all your practice and lecture *course descriptions* in the university *Coospace* site. They might be different.

Obligation to report changes to the International Office:

If there is a change in your personal data (address, e-mail address, telephone number etc.) you are required to *notify the International Office and correct the data on NEPTUN yourself* (under My Data/ Contact Information).

If you have to leave Szeged for a longer period of time during the lecture period due to reasons beyond your control (hospitalization, extraordinary family issues), you need to

request permission in writing. Requests have to be handed to the relevant teachers who declare the way of catching up. These completed requests have to be submitted to the International Office.

Student card

The *first year students* receive detailed information about requesting for a student card. For the attention of the *second, third and fourth year students*:

The student card stickers for the present semester will be available at the Students' Service Office (in TIK). You can get it, only if you have an active student status in Neptun.
